Results must be submitted to the Utah County Human Resources Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on February 1, 2017. This test measures the basic skills necessary to perform successfully as a police officer and includes Mathematics, Reading Comprehension, Grammar, and Incident Report Writing sections. Applicants must score 70% or above in each section to pass.
