5. State Storm Water program updates

Fugitive Dust was part of the program at the last State meeting. Other discussions regarding different organizations that are wanting to combine with the Storm Water programs.

The State will have a new construction permit by June of 2013. Any suggestions regarding this should be emailed and brought to attention as soon as possible.
6. Other Business

Coalition members were asked to please bring to the meeting any Storm Water questions or ideas regarding procedures or issues that they would like to address at the next State meeting.

Drying beds for street contaminants was brought up for discussion. Coalition members describe how they address the issue of street sweeping contaminants. The ultimate goal is to keep the sediments out of the rivers and lakes. The coalition asked those that attend the State meeting to make the drying and dumping a conformed process for all cities a topic of discussion at the next State meeting.

Storm Water Advertising suggestions were to purchase space on a billboard sign. The cost will be researched. The cost to add the County Storm Water Coalition's logo to other advertising with the State would cost approximately \$25,000.00 which the Coalition knows is higher than they can afford. They discussed the possibility of setting aside \$10,000.00 out of the budget for advertising. Glen will approach the advertisers to see if they can find some space for that amount.
