Whereas, Utah County Health Department Rules For Recycling of Waste Tires was adopted by the Utah County Board of Health effective June 29, 1993 for the purpose of regulating the recycling of waste tires within Utah County, and

Whereas, Utah Code Title 19, Chapter 6, Sections 801-823, places responsibility for the regulating of waste tire recycling on the Utah Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), and

Whereas, Section 19-6-814 of the Utah Code outlines the local health department responsibility as developing a procedure to monitor partial reimbursements to waste tire recyclers, and


Whereas, Utah County Health Department Rules for Recycling of Waste Tires duplicates the responsibilities of DEQ as outlined in Utah Code 19-6-801 through 823, and SR 315-320.

Whereas, at the present time there are no waste tire recyclers within Utah County therefore, be it
