Article 29-1. Title.

29-1-1. Title.

This Chapter shall be known as the “Local Option Transportation Corridor Preservation Fee Ordinance” for Utah County, Utah. (Ord. 2006-8, 3-28-2006).

Article 29-2. Purpose.

29-2-1. Purpose.

The Utah State Legislature has authorized counties to enact a Local Option Transportation Corridor Preservation Fee that may be collected at the time application is made for the registration or the renewal of the registration of a motor vehicle under assessment and collection of fee pursuant to Sections 72-2-117, 72-2-117.5, and 41-1a-1222, Utah Code Annotated, 1953 as amended. (Ord. 2006-8, 3-28-2006).

29-3-1. Local Option Transportation Corridor Preservation Fee.

There is hereby assessed upon each motor vehicle, at the time application is made for the registration or the renewal of the registration of the motor vehicle, a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). (Ord. 2006-8, 3-28-2006).

29-3-2. Exemption to the Local Option Transportation Corridor Preservation Fee.

A motor vehicle that is exempt from the registration fee under Section 41-1a-1209 or Subsection 41-1a-419(3), Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, is also exempt from this Local Option Transportation Corridor Preservation Fee. A commercial motor vehicle with an apportioned registration under Section 41-1a-301, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, is exempt from the Local Option Transportation Corridor Preservation Fee. (Ord. 2006-8, 3-28-2006).

Utah County Code

29-3-3. Use of the Local Option Transportation Corridor Preservation Fee.

Revenues generated from the collection of the Local Option Transportation Corridor Preservation Fee shall be:

(a) Deposited in the Local Option Transportation Corridor Preservation Fund created in Sections 72-2-117 and 72-2-117.5, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended; and

(b) Used and distributed in accordance with Section 72-2-117.5, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended.

(c) The Board of County Commissioners of Utah County, Utah shall, upon finding that the requirements of Section 72-2-117.5, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, are met, approve the expenditure of funds from the Local Option Transportation Corridor Preservation Fund. (Ord. 2006-8, 3-28-2006).

Article 29-4. Notice.

29-4-1. Notice.

Notice shall be given by Utah County before a fee is enacted, changed, or repealed. The notice shall include:

(a) A statement that Utah County will enact, change, or repeal the fee;

(b) The amount of the enactment or change in the fee;

(c) A copy of the ordinance imposing the fee; (Ord. 2006-8, 3-28-2006).
