Software update

A new software version has completed beta testing and will start being deployed to station analyzers the week of July 17, 2017. This will occur during normal nightly communication to the analyzer. You will likely not notice that it has happened other than the changes listed below.

The OBD self check is no longer required. The self-check can be performed to test the equipment if OBD communication with the vehicle fails, however the analyzer will not lockout if the self-check fails.

This change will allow the analyzer to still be used to diagnose communication issues but at the same time not prevent the machine from testing should a failure be indicated during self test.
