

How to Cast Your Ballot in Utah County

You may cast your ballot by utilizing any of the following voting methods:

- 1) **Drop Box.** Deposit your ballot at one of our many drop box locations. The list of drop box locations can be found at https://www.utahcounty.gov/Dept/Clerk/Elections/where/Curbside.html.
- 2) Mail-In Voting. Make sure your ballot is postmarked on or before general election day (November 21st). We recommend you take your ballot into the post office and have it postmarked by a postal worker.
- 3) Early In-person Voting. Early in-person voting will be held from November 13th through November 20th at the Elections Office in the Utah County Administration building, located at 100 E. Center St. Suite 3100, Provo, UT 84606, during normal business hours (8am to 5pm). You will need to bring an acceptable form of identification*.
- 4) **In-Person Voting.** On general election day (November 21st), nine vote centers will be open from 7am to 8pm. To vote in person, you will need to bring an acceptable form of identification*.

- 5) Fast Cast. Utah County is piloting a new way to cast your mail-in ballot. To vote this way, bring the ballot that was mailed to you to one of the vote centers between 7am and 8pm on general election day (November 21st). You will also have to bring an acceptable form of identification*. You cannot drop off another person's ballot using this method.
