Proposal to Enact a Sales and Use Tax for Cultural Arts and Recreation (PARC) Tax

Parks, Arts, Recreation, and Culture (PARC) Tax

Shall Lehi, Utah, be authorized to impose a 0.1% (1 cent per \$10 spent) sales and use tax to help fund recreational amenities, park facilities, cultural facilities and arts facilities and organizations in Lehi?
