

The Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act
(UOCAVA) Election Notice
UCA 20A-16-502
July 24, 2026

Our records show you're eligible to vote under the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA). You can vote in the upcoming election either with the ballot sent to you or by using a federal write-in absentee ballot (FWAB).

If you don't receive a ballot in time to vote, you may complete a FWAB. When using a federal write-in absentee ballot, fill out the Voter Information section completely and accurately. Last day to request a ballot: 11/2/2026

Postmark deadline: 11/2/2026

FWAB Deadline: 11/2/2026

Primary Election Day: 11/3/2026

Election Canvass: 11/17/2026

Electronic ballots must be received by the Elections Office by 8:00 PM (Mountain Standard Time) on Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, 2026. Mailed ballots must be postmarked no later than the day before Election Day, Monday, November 2, 2026, and received by the day before Election Canvass(4:59 pm on Monday, November 16, 2026). For more information on the use of the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA), the Federal Voting Assistance Program (fvap.gov), and related deadlines, or the use of a Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB), please visit Utah County Election Division website at vote.utahcounty.gov.
