<p><b>1<sup>st</sup> Amendment</b> Freedom of speech, religion, and the press</p> 	<p><b>2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment</b> The right to bear arms</p> 
<p><b>3<sup>rd</sup> Amendment</b> Right to refuse quarters to soldiers</p> 	<p><b>4<sup>th</sup> Amendment</b> Protects people from unreasonable search and seizure</p> 
<p><b>5<sup>th</sup> Amendment</b> Protects people from being held for a crime, unless accused, double jeopardy, and self-incrimination</p> 	<p><b>6<sup>th</sup> Amendment</b> Right to fair and speedy trial</p> 
<p><b>7<sup>th</sup> Amendment</b> Right to trial by jury</p> 	<p><b>8<sup>th</sup> Amendment</b> Protects from cruel and unusual punishment</p> 
<p><b>9<sup>th</sup> Amendment</b> Not all rights are listed in the Constitution</p> 	<p><b>10<sup>th</sup> Amendment</b> Power not granted to the Federal Government belongs to the States and the people</p>
